BATTLESPACE COMMUNICATIONS

Our team recently completed over 7300 pages of updated technical publications including 440 content and 70 Repair Parts Scales illustrations, for Defence's Communications Security (COMSEC) Remediation program that will procure, certify and integrate new radios into Australian Defence Force (ADF) equipment, to replace existing capability that is subject to cryptographic obsolescence.

Working on behalf of the prime contractor but directly to Defence, our team was responsible for not only technical authoring and illustrations, but also stakeholder management, reporting and the development of the full publications package (PUBPACK) under their prime contract.

DOCTRINE DEVELOPMENT

Since 2019 our team has been developing Defence Doctrine for both Army Knowledge Centre and most recently as part of the Lessons and Doctrine Directorate (LDD) of the Vice Chief of Defence Force (VCDF) Group.

Our Publication Developers support Doctrine Directorate to maintain the Australian Defence Force (ADF) Doctrine Hierarchy.

They are responsible for project management, consultation, research, analysis, development and delivery of specified publications within a 48 week doctrine development timeline in accordance with the ADF Doctrine Handbook.

MIAI ABRAMS TANK

Our team completed over 1250 pages of restructured and formatted technical publications for the Australian Army's M1A1 Abrams Main Battle Tank as part of PLAN CENTAUR including updated handbooks, instructions, manuals, and service publications.

The content was drawn from a number of existing Australian and international publications as well as from stakeholder engagement while new content was developed by working alongside subject matter experts for this fleet of armoured vehicles.
